TV appearance leads to charges



An Annapolis man was charged in a home invasion after he appeared on the *Anne Arundel County's Most Wanted* TV show.

The cable show, a localized version of *America's Most Wanted*, did a segment on the Feb. 6 incident at a home on the 1000 block of Boucher Avenue, where two men burst in and demanded money. One of the invaders pistol-whipped the victim on his head, then the two fled with over \$10,000 of the victim's belongings.

Michael Leonard Bias, 21, was identified as one of the perpetrators and had been sought by police ever since. After his TV appearance, an officer seeking Bias found him about 7 p.m. Thursday in an apartment on the 1900 block of Copeland Street.

He was arrested and charged with burglary, assault, theft and related offenses.
